## UPDATES ON UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSIONS

The University of Delhi started inviting applications for admission to its Undergraduate Programs on 17<sup>th</sup> June, 2025 through the Common Seat Allocation System (CSAS).

After the declaration of CUET results, Phase II of the CSAS platform was launched. In Phase II, the candidates could fill choices for their Programs and Colleges in which they wish to seek admissions.

This year, the University of Delhi has received highest number of candidates aspiring to take admissions to 71,642 seats in 79 Programs offered in 69 Colleges and various of departments of the University.

The following summarizes the data based on the choices received from the candidates on the CSAS portal.

As per the announced schedule, Common Simulated Ranks will be declared on the dashboard of the candidates at 05:00 p.m. 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. These ranks will be based on the preferences received till 14<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. Considering the data received, the University is expecting more than 5,75,80,700 Program + College preferences on 1549 unique Program + College combinations.

On the declaration of Simulated Ranks, the University will again open the window for the candidates to change their preferences. This window will be open till 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. In case a candidate wishes to update/revise/add/delete/reorder any preference, s(he) may do so till 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, 16<sup>th</sup> July, 2025. The candidates must, however, ensure to "Save" their preferences at regular intervals. Only the preferences saved will be used for regular allocation.

Simulated Ranks are purely tentative ranks based on the scores and preferences submitted by the candidates at the end of Phase II. These Ranks should not be construed as a warranty, express or implied, or creation of a legitimate expectation or as final ranks for allocations of a program of study or college/department/Centre whatsoever.

The first list of CSAS allocation will be declared on 05:00 p.m., Saturday, 19<sup>th</sup> July, 2025.
