Registration Fee for Admission under Visvesvarya PhD Programme, 2025-26 (other categories SC/ST/PWD etc.) - Rs. 350/-

#### **About the Scheme:**

The fellowship scheme is available only for scholars admitted as full-time Ph.D. The Terms and Conditions governing the scheme are as follows:

- Fellowship: Rs 38,750/- per month (I & II year); Rs 43,750/- (III to V year) to each candidate.
- Research Contingency Grant Support: An amount of Rs. 1,20,000/Year to each candidate during the duration of the Ph.D. program.
- Reimbursement of Rent for those full-time Ph.D. candidates who are not provided hostel/institute accommodation: The ceiling for Reimbursement of Rent would be 24%, 16%, and 8% of the fellowship amount as per the Government of India norms for class X, Y or Z cities respectively.
- One-time support for attending the International Conference for selected candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria based on the guidelines to be provided in due course
- One-time support for visits to Labs abroad for selected candidates fulfilling eligibility criteria based on the guidelines to be provided in due course.

### **Minimum Eligibility Requirements:**

A candidate interested in applying for admission to the Ph.D. program of the department under this scheme must satisfy the minimum eligibility requirements as follows:

- M.Sc./ MCA/ M.Tech./ M.E./M.S. or equivalent post-graduate degree in a relevant discipline with CGPA equivalent to 55% marks (Unreserved Category)/ 50% marks (SC/ST/PWD/OBC/EWS Category)
- B.E./ B.Tech. or equivalent four-year undergraduate degree in a relevant discipline with CGPA equivalent to 75% marks (Unreserved Category)/ 70% marks (SC/ST/PWD/OBC/EWS Category)

#### **Application and Selection Process:**

Candidates must fill out the google registration Form and upload a PDF file containing relevant certificates, and mark sheets. All scanned documents must be self-attested on every page and compiled into one merged PDF file. The complete file must be uploaded during online registration. LINK of GOOGLE REGISTRATION FORM.

- The application form of candidates who have successfully applied will be scrutinized. The candidates who have passed M.Phil. or NET (category 1/2/3) in a relevant subject, or an equivalent examination are only eligible to apply.
- Departments/Centres reserve the right not to fill up the vacant seats of the Ph.D. Programs in case of non-availability of suitable candidate.

• The final selection of the candidates will be subject to verification of their academic credentials and the provisions of the ordinances governing the Ph.D. program of the University.
